Hunter Mobile Preschool is a not-for-profit, community based organisation, established in 1979 that provides care services for children in rural remote areas of the Hunter region.

We are seeking enthusiastic, motivated and suitably qualified people to run and manage the program of our new Outside School Hours Care service at Gresford Public School.

The positions will be on a job share basis at the 15 place service with a weekly rotation roster between morning and afternoon shifts with crossover administration time to spend planning and implementing the OSHC program as a team, totalling 66 hours per fortnight.
